






SciCat Interfaces

Frontend




Backend (REST API, Swagger)

Elastic Search: benefits




- Elasticsearch is optional.
 It can be enabled in configuration.
- Provides advanced search through a dedicated endpoint
- Transparent data syncronization between MongoDB (main database) and ElasticSearch.
- Enhance search functionalities
 by leveraging ElasticSearch Tokenizers and Analyzers
- Results ranking with relevancy score provided by ElasticSearch






Moving forward

- Code not following best practices




Version 4

- Code refactoring: Modularity
- Use of official SciCat version containers
- Better testing

- Develop plugin system to foster contributions and new functionalities (Future effort)




Jobs Configuration
